Horse of the Decades

Be part of the nationwide effort to recognize the historic accomplishments of War Paint – Horse of the Decades by becoming a donor to the War Paint Statue project. War Paint will be honored with a larger than life (1.25 size) bronze statue planned for placement in front of the Pendleton Round-Up & Happy Canyon Hall of Fame Museum. Appropriately landscaped, War Paint will be looking directly across the street to the Pendleton Round-Up arena where he was a crowd favorite. The statue will feature one of his National Championship silver halters, a Casey Tibb's saddle made by Severe Brothers and War Paint's unique markings in various color tones of metal.

War Paint, the product of a registered Quarter Horse stud and a wild pinto mare, was raised by Ora Summers on the Klamath Indian Reservation in Oregon and sold as a 3-year-old to the Christensen Brothers Rodeo Stock Contractors. War Paint quickly became a star competitor and went on to become the greatest saddle bronc horse of his generation.

Noted for his incredible bucking style, War Paint held an unheard of 90% buck-off record during his 20-year career. Highly respected by cowboys across the country, War Paint was honored three times as the "Bucking Horse of the Year" by the Pro Rodeo Cowboy Association. He was nominated for the first award in 1956 by Casey Tibbs, receiving the honor again in 1957 and 1958. War Paint has been inducted into the Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame as well as three Rodeo Hall of Fames including the Pendleton Round-Up & Happy Canyon Hall of Fame.



SCULPTOR

Edd Hayes of Humble, Texas is serving as sculptor for the War Paint bronze statue. Edd has over 40 years' experience as a specialist in planning, design, and installation of monumental bronze sculptures/statues. Examples of his work include "The Champ" located in front of the Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame and "Wild & Free" located at the Huston Astrodome.
